## CHÂTEAU CURTON LA PERRIERE

RED BORDEAUX - VINTAGE 2020

The vineyard is located on a plateau at an altitude of 110 metres at its highest, at Jugazan, a wine-growing village situated at 15kms south of Saint-Émilion.



### AGE AND SURFACE OF THE VINES

30 years / 20 hectares



### GRAPE VARIETIES AND TERROIRS

100 % Merlot

The vines lay on 3 very distinct terroirs: clay-limestone for the first one, compact clay for the second and lastly, a rare mixture of clay and gravel for the third terroir.



### ALCOHOL CONTENT

14.5 %



### CULTIVATION METHODS

Cultivation methods in accordance with the ecosystem and the balance of the wine for a responsible and sustainable wine-growing.



### WINEMAKING AND AGING

Maceration and fermentation in temperature-controlled stainless-steel vats. After a rigorous selection, the wine-making is tailored to each grape profile, aiming at expressing the fruit and the delicacy of the tannins.

The wines are aged in stainless vats at a constant temperature of 15° throughout the year.



### CERTIFICATION

Certified High Environmental Value estate.



### AWARDS

The 2020 Château Curton La Perrière won a gold medal at the Lyon competition, as well as a 2-stars rating in the Guide Hachette 2023, which makes it an outstanding wine.

Juries also awarded it a special merit.
